# January to March Lost Time Incidents

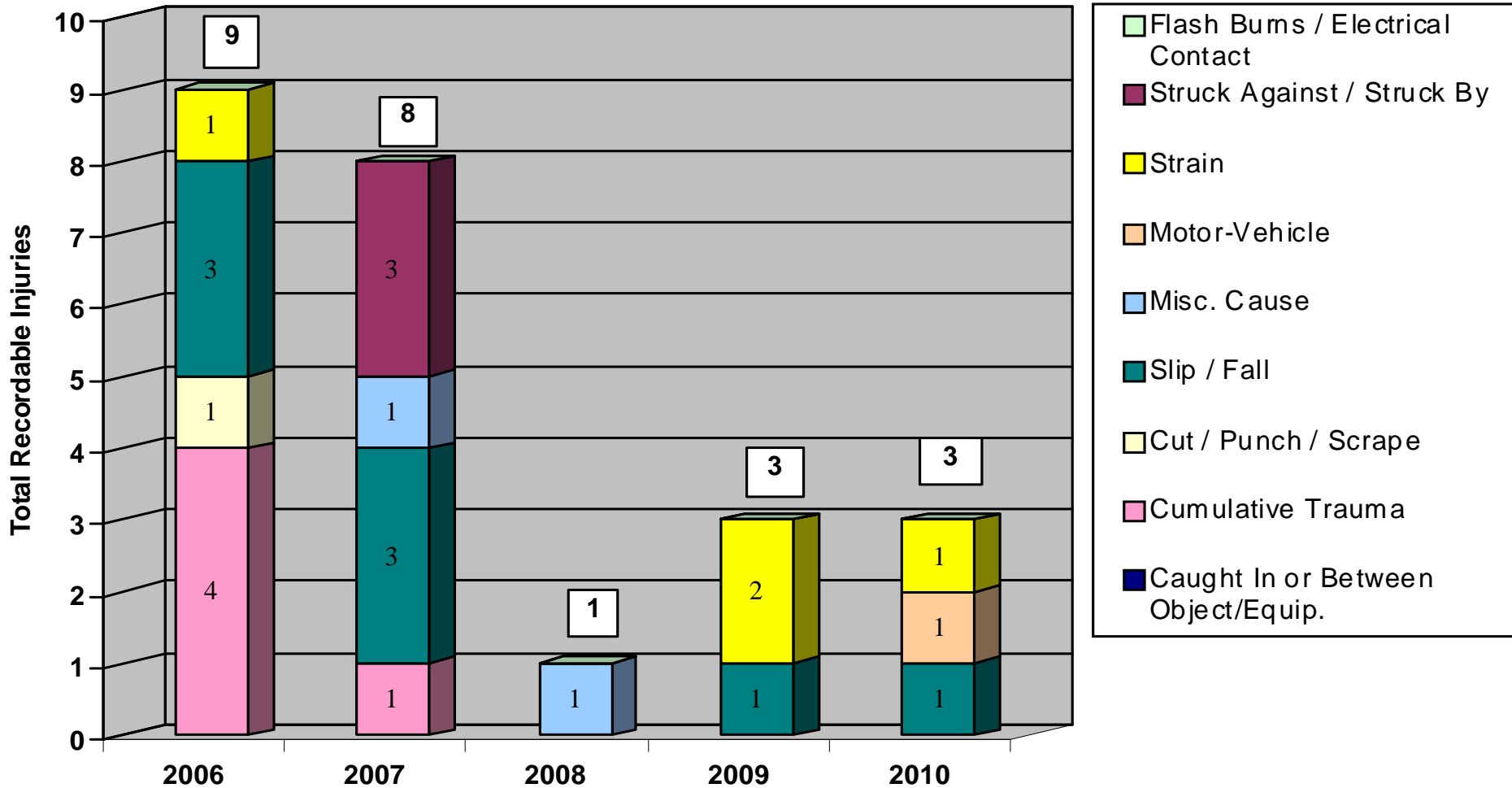
- None – First quarter without lost time injury since 2002.

# January to March Recordable Only Incidents

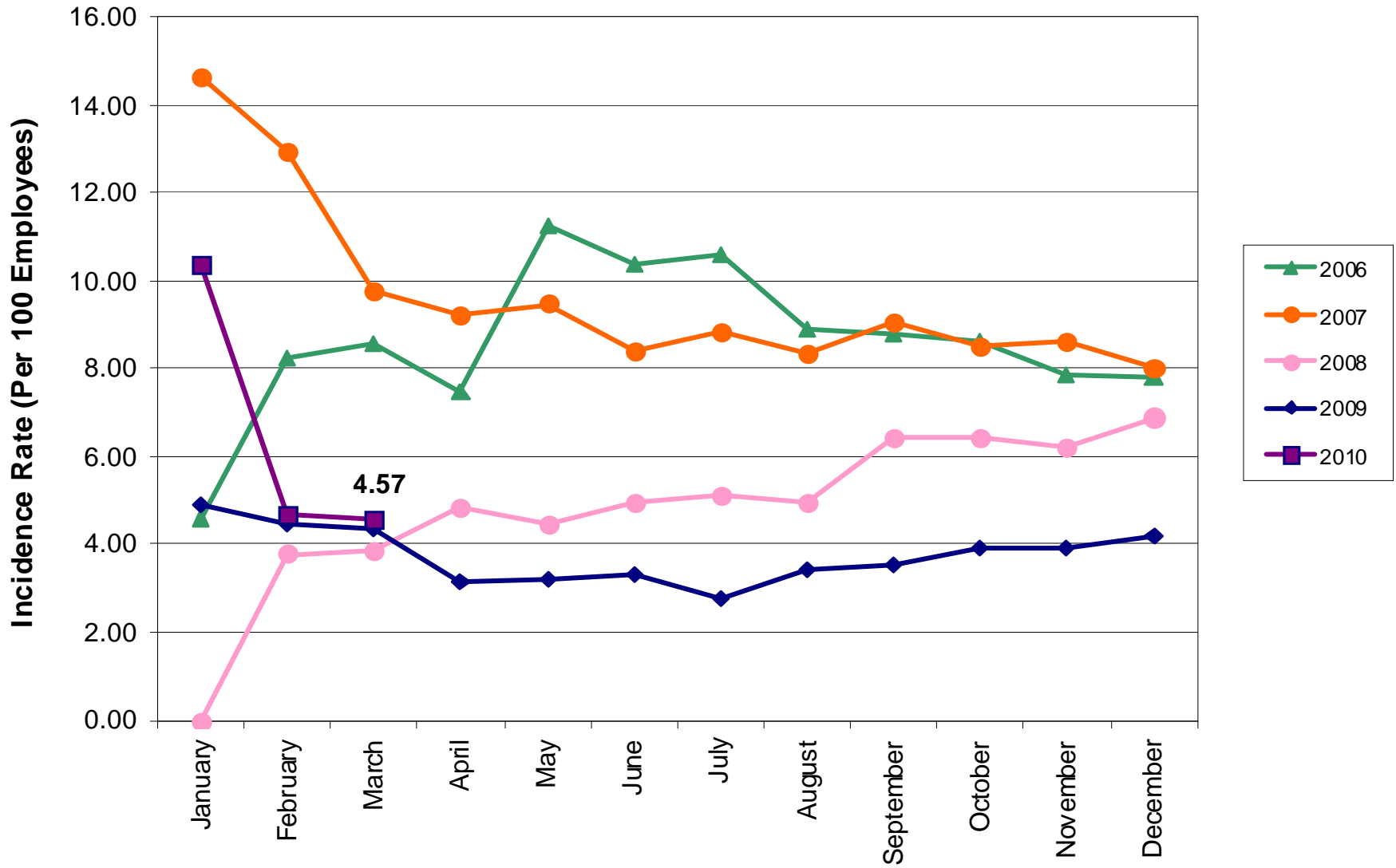
## ■ Strains:

- Vehicle incident back strain when contact with another vehicle (Power Delivery)

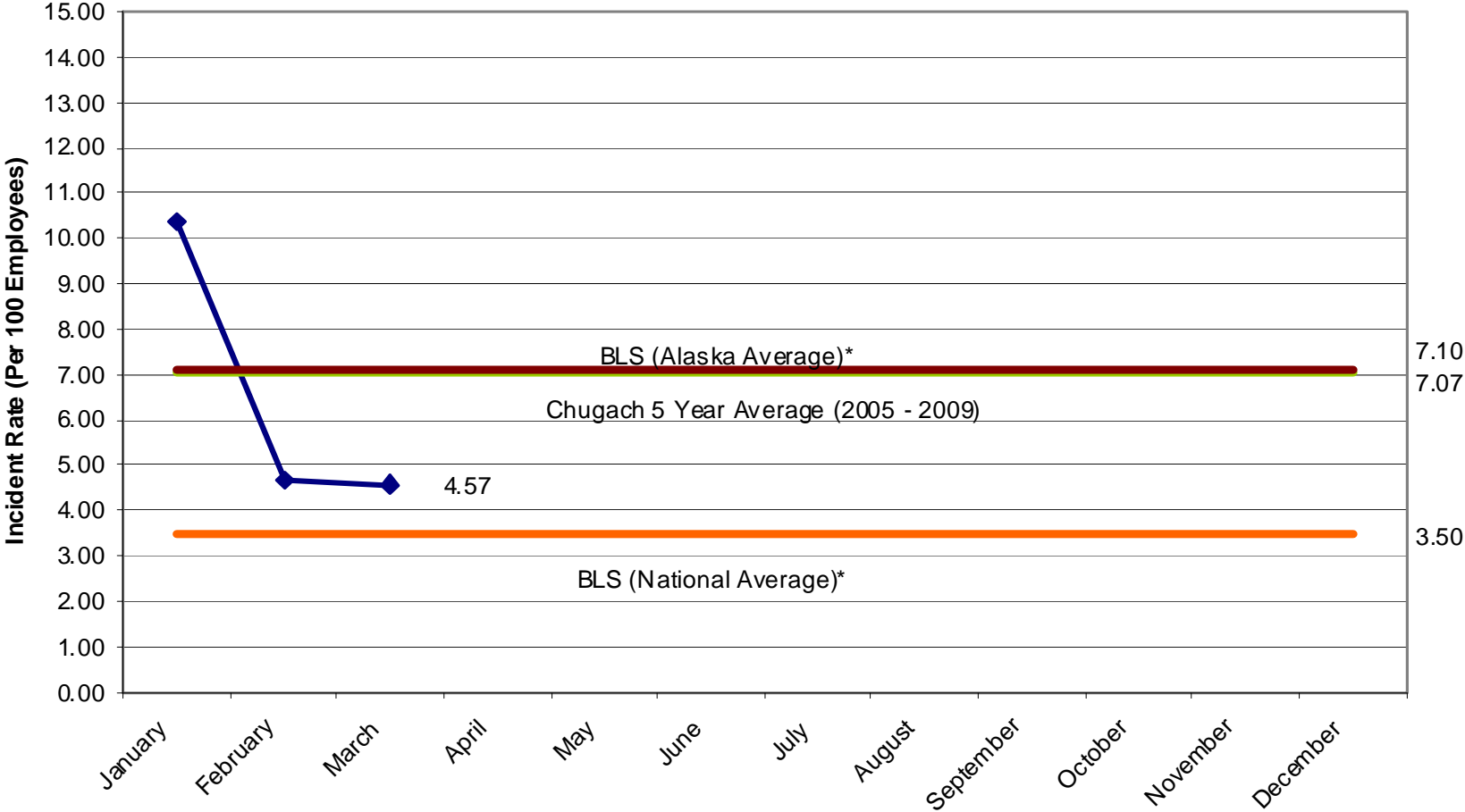
## Causes of Recordable Injuries Year-to-Date Through March In Each Year



# OSHA Recordable Incidence Rate March 2010

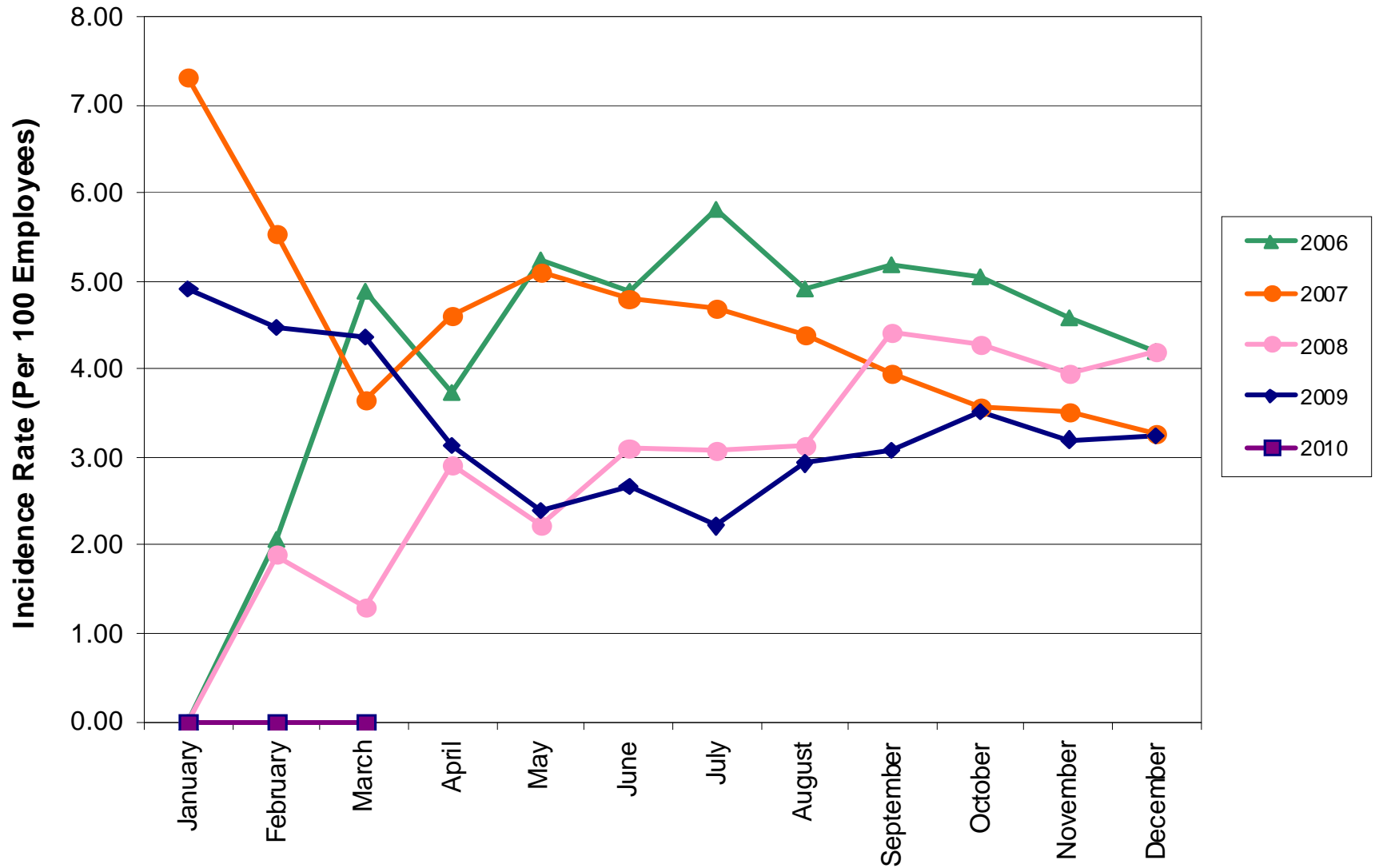

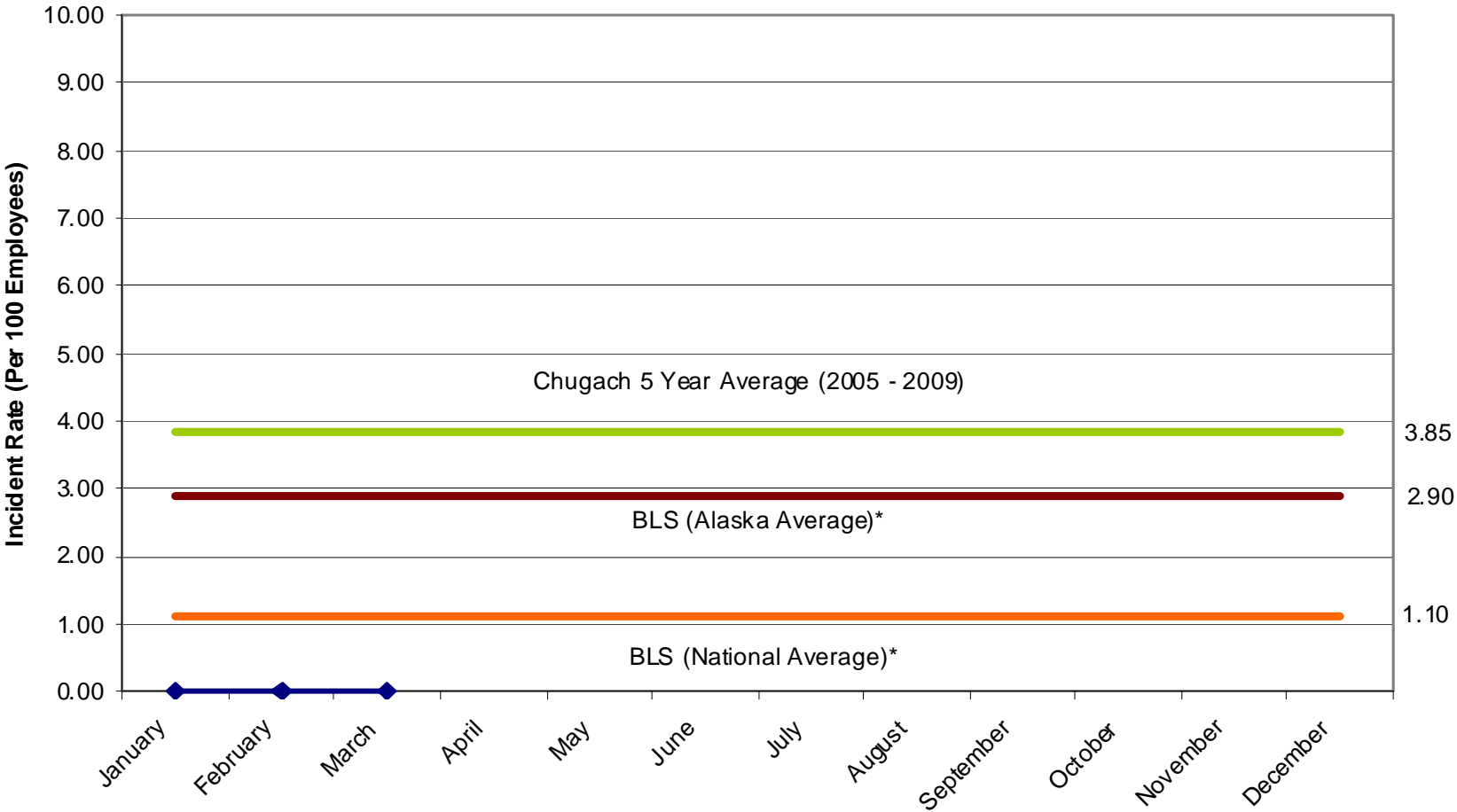

## Lost Time Recordable Incidence Rate Per 100 Employees

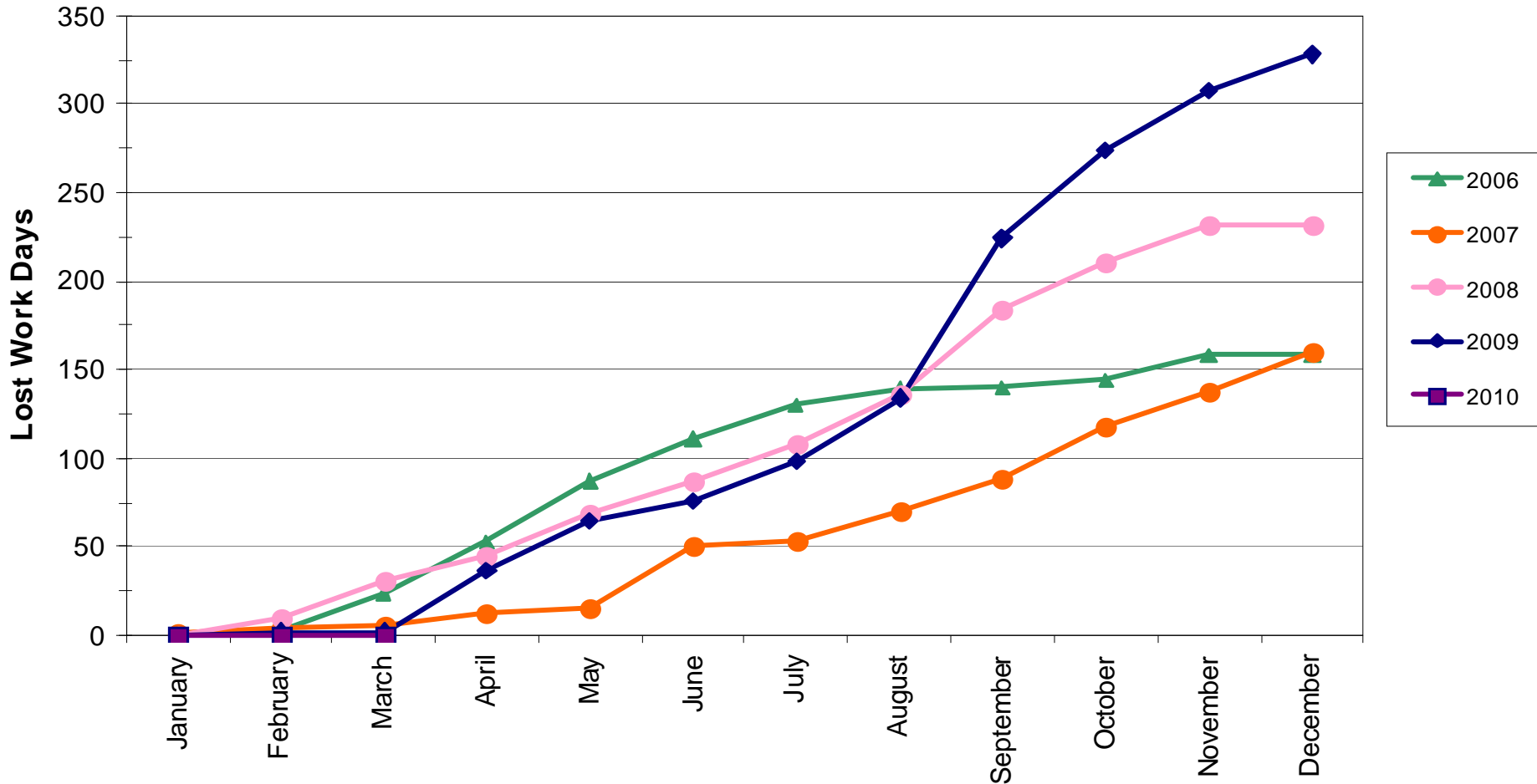


# Lost Time Recordable Incidence Significance of Change

## Cumulative Number of Lost Work Days\* March 2010

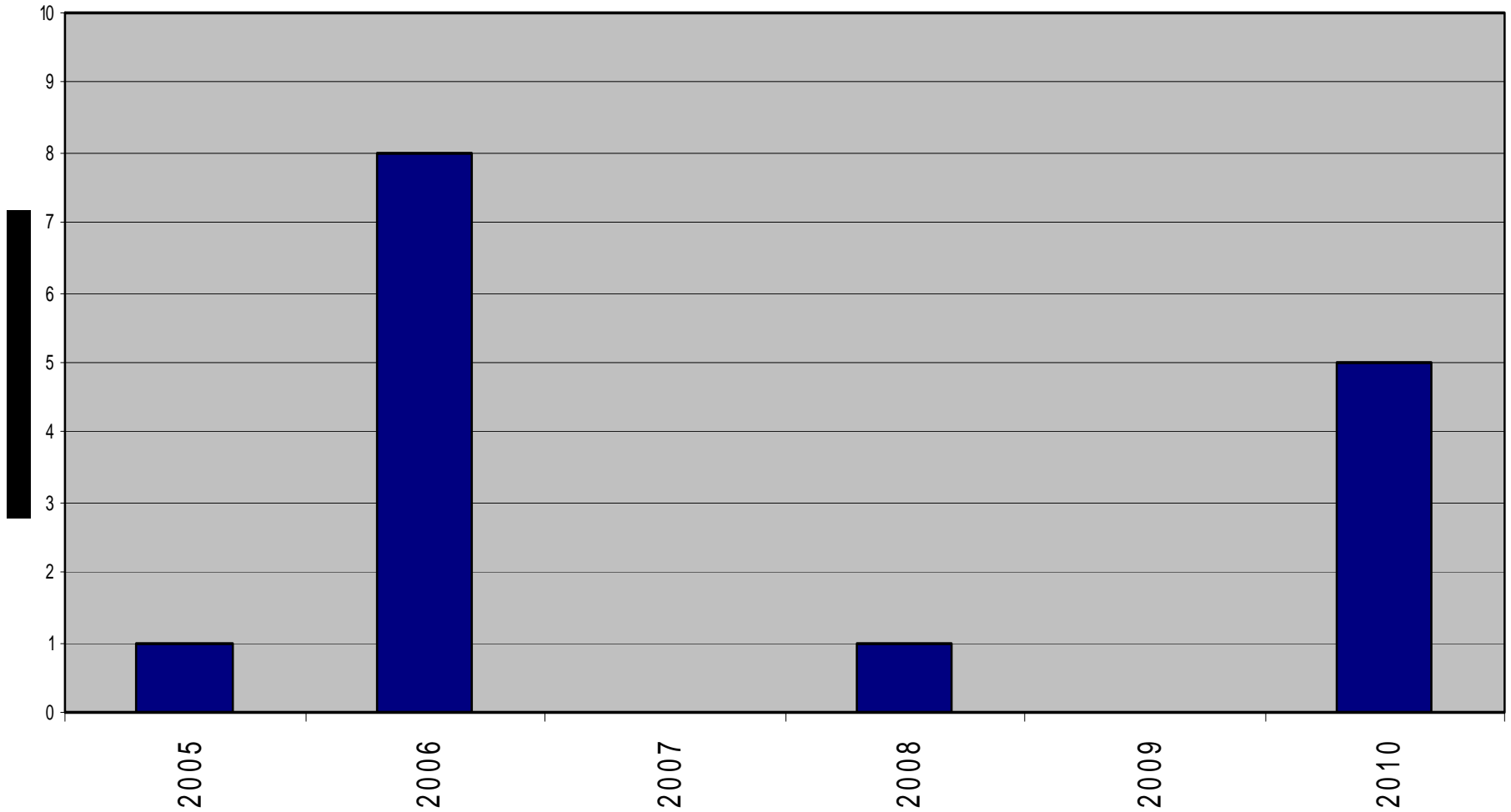


\* Reflects only lost work days for injuries incurred during indicated year

# January to March Vehicle Incidents

- Substation crew lost control of a snowmachine trailer at MP75 Seward Highway, no injury
- Meter disconnect lineman unable to stop for a yield “right of way” injury
- Designer did not see vehicle and went through a stop sign 56<sup>th</sup> and Electron Drive, no injury
- Substation lineman encountered a moose at 56<sup>th</sup> and Electron Drive, no injury
- Power plant employee backed into a parked vehicle by the Dimond center hotel, no injury
