I. CONVENE MEETING

Chair Reiser convened the Operations Committee Meeting at 4:07 p.m. in the boardroom of Chugach Electric Association, Inc., 5601 Electron Drive, Anchorage, Alaska.

a. Safety Minute

Dave Smith, Senior Vice President, Administration gave a Safety Minute presentation and played a video clip on wind chill. Mr. Smith distributed a wind chill factor card and high energy bars to the Committee members.

III. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Director Logan moved and Director Gimarc seconded the motion to approve the Agenda.

Chair Reiser amended the agenda by moving Agenda Item VIII.b. "Disband the Chugach Renewable Energy Committee" to Agenda Item VIII.a. and Agenda Item VIII. a. "Create a Future Energy Committee" was moved to Agenda Item VIII.b. The motion passed unanimously, as amended.

IV. APPROVAL OF MINUTES*

a. January 13, 2010

Director Logan moved and Director Gimarc seconded the motion to approve the meeting minutes. The motion passed unanimously.

VI. UPDATE ON SOUTHCENTRAL POWER PROJECT

Dustin Highers, Director, Power Supply Technical Services gave an update on the Southcentral Power Project and answered questions from the Committee.

VII. UNIT 6C INSPECTION – PROJECT AUTHORIZATION RECOMMENDATION

Paul Risse, Senior Vice President, Power Supply gave an overview on the Beluga Unit 6 C Inspection and answered questions from the Committee.

Director Logan moved and Direction Nordlund seconded the motion that the Operations Committee recommend the Board of Directors authorize the project expenditure for Beluga Unit 6C Inspection with the estimated cost of \$10,575,044 and an estimated completion date of September 2010. The motion passed unanimously.

VIII. RENEWABLE ENERGY COMMITTEE CHARTER

The order of the previous 3 items was requested by Chair Reiser during the Approval of the Agenda earlier in this meeting. Director Logan moved and Director Gimarc seconded the motion for the item re-ordering. The motion passed unanimously.

a. Disband the Chugach Renewable Energy Committee
Director Gimarc moved and rescinded his motion to disband the Renewal Energy Committee. Director Gimarc then moved to create a future energy committee and make a correction to the alternative energy resolution that was passed 1-1/2 years ago.

b. Create a Future Energy Committee
After discussion no action was taken.

c. Support of Alternative Energy in Alaska

Director Logan moved and Director Gimarc seconded the motion that the Operations Committee recommend the Board of Directors approve the attached resolution to support the continued study of alternative electric generation solutions to decrease our reliance on Cook Inlet natural gas.

Chair Reiser called for a vote. Chair Reiser, Directors Nordlund, Logan, Kennedy, Hill and Vazquez voted yes. Director Gimarc voted no. The motion passed.

IX. BYLAW CHANGE – Non-Natural Entity Board Candidate Qualifications

Director Logan moved and Director Gimarc seconded the motion to approve the proposed Bylaw amendment to Article III, Section 9(b) and Article IV, Section 3(b) and refer it to the Board for its approval and placement on the ballot for the 2010 annual membership meeting. The motion passed unanimously.

The motion passed unanimously.
