One battery system and rack assembly is for replacement of existing system at Bernice Lake Power Plant eight miles north of Kenai, Alaska. The other battery system, rack assembly, and two battery chargers are for the International Generation Facility located in Anchorage, Alaska.

Potential proposers should call Lisa Reed at 907-762-4764, no later than 12:00 Noon, AST, April 27, 2009, to make a reservation to attend the Site Meeting. Proposers may send up to two representatives. Notes from the April 28, 2009 Pre-Proposal Site meeting will be made available for all potential proposers.

Questions related to this RFP and as those that result from the Pre-Proposal Site Meeting, are due no later than, 4:00 PM, AST, May 1, 2009. Responses to questions will be provided by 5:00 PM, AST, May 4, 2009. Electronic (e-mail) submission of questions is preferred.

Chugach will require a Performance Bond to guarantee the work.

The work is not subject to the union signatory section, Section 2.12.4(a), of Chugach's Generation Agreement.

The work is subject to the union standards section, Section 2.12.4(c)(1), of Chugach's Generation Agreement. Such work shall be compensated at the current prevailing rate of wages and fringe benefits determined by the Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development pursuant to Title 36. Pursuant to the April 1, 2008 version of Pamphlet 600, that rate for Classification A0702 is currently \$53.28 per hour. Payroll records shall be prepared, maintained and delivered to Chugach as described in AS 36.05.040 and implementing regulations.

Proposals are to be valid for 30 days from the proposal due date.
