Rate Case Update

rder From Regulatory Commission of Alaska Impacts Chugach Finances

As we have reported in the past, in 2001 Chugach filed with the Regulatory Commission of Alaska (RCA) for a small rate increase and a change in the way rates are set. The RCA recently issued their order. While some rulings were favorable, others were unfavorable and could have a profound effect on the financial strength of our cooperative now and in the future.



Some of the impacts of the RCA order are outlined below:

- It reduces Chugach's ability to distribute Capital Credits to members
- It requires a \$1.1 million refund in 2001 and \$6 million in 2002
- It places Chugach out of compliance with debt covenants in 2002
- It results in a \$2 million loss in 2002, instead of an \$8 million margin

We believe the RCA's Order, if not amended, could significantly impair our ability to operate Chugach in a financially responsible manner and could ultimately decrease reliability and increase the cost of electricity to Chugach members. For that reason, Chugach will ask the RCA to reconsider some parts of the order and work to find a fair and more reasonable resolution.

You may read or hear negative publicity about Chugach's response to the RCA order but be assured your board and management are working in your interest to meet our mission requirement: "Through superior service, safely provide reliable and competitively priced energy." •••
