TOPIC

ML&P Acquisition Agreements

DISCUSSION

On December 19, 2018, the Chugach Electric Association, Inc. Board of Directors ("Board") authorized the Chief Executive Officer to execute and deliver the Asset Purchase and Sale Agreement ("APA"), the Eklutna Power Purchase Agreement ("Eklutna PPA"), the Beluga River Unit Fuel Agreement ("BRU Fuel Agreement"), and the Payment in Lieu of Taxes Agreement ("PILT Agreement") (collectively, the "Transaction Agreements").

On October 3, 2019, the Board approved a stipulated Settlement agreement with the parties in the Regulatory Commission of Alaska's ("Commission") docket established to review and approve the acquisition. At this meeting, the Board also approved of associated Transaction Agreement amendments.

On May 28, 2020, the Commission approved the Transaction Agreements but required certain amendments to the APA, Eklutna PPA, PILT Agreement, and BRU Fuel Agreement that must be authorized and approved by the Chugach Board of Directors. Chugach has negotiated and agreed upon further amendments to the Transaction Agreements.

MOTION

Move that the Board of Directors approve the attached Resolution authorizing the Chief Executive Officer to execute and deliver the Amendments, including the APA Amendment No. 3; the Eklutna PPA Amendment No. 3; the PILT Agreement Amendment No. 3; and, the BRU Fuel Agreement Termination Agreement in substantially the same form as attached and to take all other actions as described in the Resolution and discussed in executive session.

TOPIC

Chugach/MEA Operations Agreement for Pooling and Joint Dispatch

DISCUSSION

The Board of Directors approved The Amended and Restated Power Pooling and Joint Dispatch Agreement among Chugach, ML&P and MEA on November 30, 2016. This agreement was executed by Chugach, ML&P and MEA, and filed with the Regulatory Commission of Alaska (RCA) as an informational filing in January 2017 ("2017 Pooling Agreement"). Chugach, ML&P and MEA continued development of the power pooling dispatch and settlement processes required under the 2017 Pooling Agreement until October 2018. At that time, Chugach paused development of the 2017 Pooling Agreement dispatch and settlement processes pending the outcome of Chugach's acquisition of ML&P. On May 28, 2020, the RCA conditionally approved Chugach's acquisition of ML&P. One of the conditions required Chugach and MEA to file a power pooling agreement with the specific terms identified in the RCA's Final Order. Chugach and MEA finalized a power pooling agreement on June 30, 2020, and are pursuing approval of the Agreement from their respective Boards.

MOTION

Move that the Board of Directors authorize the Chief Executive Officer to negotiate and finalize the terms and conditions of the Operations Agreement for Power Pooling and Joint Dispatch essentially the same as discussed in Executive Session.

Board Consulting Contract with Susan Reeves

DISCUSSION

For many years, Chugach Electric Association, Inc. has been involved in the acquisition of Municipal Light & Power. In 2018, the Board of Directors, after having spent many months reviewing and analyzing the acquisition documents, authorized the Chief Executive Officer to execute transaction agreement to accomplish the acquisition. Susan Reeves was a Board member during the entirety of these negotiations and deliberations and played an active role in providing guidance and input to staff and other Board members. Ms. Reeves' term on the Board has now terminated and the Board would like to retain Ms. Reeves as a consultant/independent contractor to provide continuity in understanding acquisition documents and actions taken related to the acquisition. Consulting services by Ms. Reeves would be to assist, consult, and advise the Board on issues related to the ML&P acquisition efforts. Under the Contract, Ms. Reeves would take direction from, and request information through, the Chugach Board Chair.

MOTION

Move that the Board of Directors authorize the Board Chair to approve and execute the attached Professional Services Contract with Susan E. Reeves. The Contract term will be through December 31, 2020 and is not to exceed \$9,500.
