Chugach Community Solar: Enrollment now open!



Construction is in full swing on Chugach's Community Solar Project, located near Retherford Substation on E 94th Ave. in Anchorage.

The Regulatory Commission of Alaska has approved the community solar tariff filing, giving Chugach members the opportunity to subscribe to Chugach Community Solar. If you're a current Chugach member, you're eligible to participate. This program is open to all retail members, including residential, small general service, and large general service members.

Chugach's initial enrollment period will open on April 1 and run through at least May 15, with the possibility of

an extension. If demand exceeds the available number of panels, a lottery will be used to determine enrollment.
