Beluga River investment surpasses \$100 million in savings

Chugach's investment in the Beluga River Unit (BRU) natural gas field in Cook Inlet has saved members more than \$100 million over the past eight years. Chugach holds a two-thirds working interest in the BRU, with Hilcorp Alaska, LLC (Hilcorp) owning the remaining one-third and serving as operator of the field.

Chugach acquired a 10% interest in 2016, and another 57% interest in the field as part of the acquisition of Municipal Light & Power in 2020. The cumulative net savings to Chugach since

2016 surpassed \$100 million in May and was \$101.2 million at the end of June. The savings from the ownership is calculated by comparing Chugach's contract price with Hilcorp to the gas transfer price of BRU gas. The current contract price to Chugach is \$7.78 per mcf and the current BRU gas transfer price is \$6.45 per mcf, which provides Chugach members a savings of \$1.33 per mcf. The savings translate into overall lower electric rates for members

natural gas field in 2023, and there are plans to drill five more wells in 2024.



Fire prevention on the Anchorage Hillside

Chugach is partnering with the Anchorage Fire Department (AFD) on an early detection program for potential wildfires on the Anchorage Hillside. Sensors that detect heat, humidity, and indications of smoke have been mounted on utility poles in 30 locations across the Hillside. Each device monitors approximately a half-acre, acting similarly to a home smoke detector but much more sophisticated.

In the event a sensor is triggered, an automatic alert goes out to both Chugach and AFD dispatch centers. The monitoring effort is a one-year pilot program and may be expanded to other parts of Anchorage and Chugach's larger service territory after results are analyzed.



Chugach-supported EV fast chargers installed at Anchorage business



The number of EV charging stations around Anchorage continues to grow with two new public charging sites coming online this summer.

ReCharge Alaska, an Anchorage-based EV charging company, recently opened a new location

on E. 33rd Ave. at the Alaska Rock Gym, featuring two 75 kW DC fast charging stations. Chugach supported the project through its Commercial DC Fast Charging incentive program.

A fast charging site at the Chugach headquarters office on Electron Drive is nearing completion and will open to the public this summer. The site will be owned by Chugach and operated by ReCharge Alaska.

Public fast charging sites enhance options for Chugach members choosing to electrify their transportation, and support growth of a new industry and jobs supporting EVs in Alaska.
