



An interim rate increase of 3.1% on a total bill basis went into effect on electric bills on Oct. 2 as the Regulatory Commission of Alaska (RCA) reviews the Chugach rate case. In August, after an unusually warm winter and an electric sales decline of over 3%, Chugach filed a request with the RCA to update its base rates.

Chugach noted the sales decline and higher costs resulted in a revenue shortfall of about \$11.2 million. It further stated it's imperative that the utility is able to meet the power needs of its members and ensure there is sufficient revenue to cover expenses and meet operational requirements in the fall and coming winter. Sufficient revenues are also important to maintain Chugach's credit ratings as those ratings impact Chugach's ability to access debt at the lowest possible cost.




As the rate case is considered by the RCA, the interim rates will be in effect. If final permanent rates are lower than interim rates, members receive a refund with interest. 




