

ML&P acquisition on track to close in October

Chugach continues to move forward on the acquisition of Municipal Light & Power (ML&P), with an anticipated closing date of Oct. 30, 2020. On May 28, the Regulatory Commission of Alaska approved the acquisition with conditions, and Chugach has been working with the Municipality of Anchorage to finalize the transaction and move to closing.

In April of 2018, Anchorage voters approved the acquisition of ML&P by Chugach by more than

65%. Over the past two years, the parties have been working through the regulatory process as employees from both utilities have been working together to plan for a combined organization. ML&P customers will begin receiving electric service from Chugach after the transaction closes.

Chugach offers electric vehicle incentive programs to members

Chugach is offering several new electric vehicle (EV) related incentives to promote the use of EVs in Alaska. Individually, the incentives are intended to help the utility's members interested in owning and driving an EV and the businesses that would like to serve them. Collectively, the programs will help Chugach learn more about the trend toward transportation electrification and its impacts on the power grid.

The incentive programs from Chugach provide bill credits for residential and commercial members who install charging equipment. Additional programs target specific types of members, like hotels and fleet owners, with reimbursements for adding EV charging stations. All are available now for Chugach members.

Another Chugach program will be available in the future once rental car companies begin offering EVs for rent. One will help pay the cost of an extended rental for Chugach members who want to see what

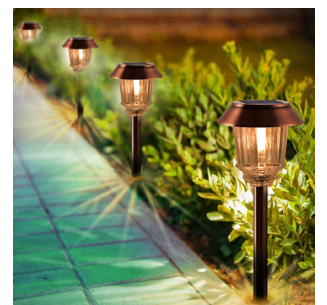
it is like to drive an EV. The other will help lease an EV for Chugach members who are transportation network drivers.
